Elementary Student Dress Code : Amended May 2008

1. Any apparel or unusual accessory that school officials have reasons to believe would disrupt normal activities is unacceptable. Cleanliness, neatness, and good taste are standards of appropriate dress.
2. Royal Blue and Red polo-style shirts without emblems/designer logos and school spirit shirts shall be worn. (Undershirts may not extend past the length of the school shirts nor the sleeves.)

***During cold weather students may wear long sleeve red, royal blue, black or grey shirts under their red, royal blue, or school spirit shirts.**
3. Blue jean or khaki (beige-cream colored khaki) standard fit walking shorts, no shorter than 3 inches above the knee, may be worn. (Not blue, green, black or brown khaki: only beige/cream colored khaki)
4. Blue jean or khaki standard fit capri pants may be worn.
5. **Blue jean or khaki standard fit trousers may be worn. No baggy, oversized trousers are allowed.**
6. Blue jean or khaki dresses and/or jumpers, skirts, and skorts, no shorter than 3 inches above the knee, may be worn.
7. Belts shall be worn with trousers designed for belts.
8. Boys hair should not extend below the top of the collar of a regular shirt, nor should the hair extend below the ear lobes or eyebrows. Hair should be clean, combed, and neatly trimmed. Sideburns should not be worn lower than below the bottom of the ear lobe and shall be kept neatly trimmed.
9. Unusual hair styles, such as “rat tails” and unnatural hair coloring (pink, green, etc.) will not be permitted. Hair curler devices, and makeup will not be permitted.
10. Mustaches, beards, or goatees shall not be permitted.
11. No headbands are to be worn by boys.
12. No leg bands shall be worn.
13. Shoes are to be worn at all times and laces must not touch the walking surface. Shoes with laces must be laced and tied. If sandals are worn they must have back straps. (No flip-flop or beach type sandals allowed.)
14. No caps or hats are to be brought to school or worn while on school grounds during school hours. (only during field day)

15. No earrings are to be worn by boys.
16. Leggings may be worn if they are worn with a shirt, tunic top, dress, skirt, or skort that meets the dress length specifications.
17. No clothing or emblems with skulls, blood, drugs, depiction of violence or suggestions of sex and/or violence should be worn.
18. **All pants must be standard fit; no baggy or over-sized pants are acceptable. Pants are to be worn at the waist. Hem of pants may be no longer than touching the top of the shoe in front, and must be off the floor in the back.**
19. Shirts shall be buttoned, except at the collar. Shirts with tails must be worn tucked inside the trousers. Elastic band or square-cut shirts may be worn outside the trousers if designed to be so worn. The length of any shirt can not be longer than the tips of the fingers.
20. Dresses, skirts, skorts, and split skirts worn shall not be shorter than three inches above the knee cap.
21. Blouses should be buttoned, except at the collar.
22. Boys and girls in grades 4,5, and 6 may wear loose fitting walking shorts. The walking shorts must be neat in appearance, not cut-off jean, not basketball style/jersey material shorts, and not over three inches above the kneecap. No wind shorts., nor frayed walking shorts.
23. Tight-fitting clothes, muscle shirt, tank tops, and t-shirts designed for wear as an undergarment are prohibited. Dresses, blouses, shirts, or other tops similar to sun dresses that have back, front, or midriff exposure are not to be worn at school. Modest attire shall be worn at school at all times.
24. Hidden wheel-style tennis shoes may not be worn.

**This dress code also applies to “Free Dress Days”, such as Picture Day.

Note: The administration reserves the right to make the final decision relative to appropriate dress.
