Dental Early Acceptance:

Participating Professional Schools:

- a. UT HSC Houston Dental Branch
- b. Baylor College of Dentistry
- c. UT HSC at San Antonio Dental School

Program: Dental Early Acceptance and 3/4 Program

Application Deadline: By the end of freshman year of college.

GPA: 3.2 to 3.4 overall in college;
3.0 to 3.4 in science courses;
2.0 grade in prerequisites.

Standardized Test Scores: FROM DAT \geq National mean of previous year TO DAT \geq 18

Recommendation/Acceptance: Health Professions Advisor letter and/or Committee Recommendation.

Other Information: Major in Biology

Medical School Early Acceptance Programs:

Participating Professional School:

- a. Texas A&M University System Health Science Center College of Medicine

Program: **Partnership for Primary Care Program**

Application Deadline: December 1 – date set in February of senior year in high school; no later than date set in February of freshman year in A&M participating University.

GPA: 3.5 for high school students, plus top 10% of HS class; 3.5 in college, minimum grade of C in prerequisites.

Standardized Test Scores: SAT: 1200 old system; ACT: 26 Minimum

Recommendation/

Acceptance: High school students – faculty recommendation;
College student – science faculty recommendations;
Selection is performed by the College of Medicine's admissions committee through interviews.

Other Information: Student must come from a medically underserved area in Texas.

Participating Professional Schools:

- a. Any Texas College of Medicine

Medical School Early Acceptance Programs continued:

Program: **Joint Admission Medical Program**

Application Deadline: February of freshman year in a participating college/university.

GPA: 3.25 overall in college.

Standardized Test Scores: SAT & ACT: \geq mean for Texas. Must take MCAT in spring of junior year in college.

Recommendation/
Acceptance: JAMP campus director of the program.

Other Information: Must qualify for a Pell Grant; complete three summer internships at two participating medical schools.
